



When should EPAs be completed?

EPAs capture feedback for students in the moment after the observation of a clinical skill by the assessor.

The benchmark used in completing the assessment is that of the graduating medical student. Students are expecting to receive a range of ratings over the course of clerkship as they develop and hone their skills.

How many EPAs?

During the WBA Pilot (March -August 2023), students are encouraged to complete a minimum of 3 EPAs in courses which are 3+ weeks in duration and 1 EPA per week for all other courses.

EPAs are not replacing any other assessments for now.

What we are hearing from you...

Assessors have told us that EPAs have been helpful in understanding students' learning goals and in structuring specific and timely feedback. They also tell us that the tool is most likely to be completed at the time of feedback or the same day.
